Town of Mount Royal Library- Free library cards for all our students

Students enrolled in a Town of Mount Royal elementary or secondary school may become library members free of charge during the school year. You must complete the form online or the one supplied by the school. To register your child, parents must go to the library with a recent proof of residence, such as a driver's license, as well as an official document in the child's name, such as a Medicare card. For students who do not live in Town of Mount Royal, the school principal will sign a document certifying that the child is enrolled at the school. Parents must bring this document, along with the two other pieces of identification required, to the library. We encourage all our students to get a library card especially since we will make use of the TMR Library resources throughout the year for our class projects. An application form will be sent to every Carlyle student.

Monday Communication

It is important that parents verify their child's agenda on a daily basis for homework, communication and/or information distributed for parents viewing. The school will do its best to send all documents, forms and news on Mondays. However, if there are important forms/documents, it will be sent on that given day.
