### **NEW NAME, SAME GREAT SERVICE LEARN Launches S.O.S LEARN (FREE Online Tutoring)**

Is your child drowning in homework? In over his/her head with assignments? S.O.S. LEARN can help. Online tutoring resumed this week for **S.O.S. LEARN**, formerly Online Tutorials and Homework Help, a service available **free** to students registered in English Schools in Quebec. This is the third year LEARN has provided this popular service to students across the province.

**S.O.S. LEARN**, the new name and logo featuring a life-preserver, reflects the immediate help available to students offered by LEARN. **S.O.S.**, Student Online Support, is offered through tutoring on weekday evenings: three evenings a week from 6 to 8 PM for secondary students and four nights a week from 5 to 7 PM for elementary children. Students and teachers meet in a virtual classroom, the next best thing to the real classroom. Students log in through the website ([www.learnquebec.ca](http://www.learnquebec.ca)) and register with the username and password provided by their school. They access to the virtual classroom where they are able to hear and talk to the tutor and other students in the session, type in questions in a chat frame, and write on a virtual white board just using a mouse. The classroom is very easy to use, even for a novice internet user, but students can contact our toll-free help desk (1-877-647-6060) and we will gladly guide students through the process. Students may request help with a specific homework problem, or a more general topic. Teachers work through the problem with the child and often provide similar practice questions to check for understanding.

All online tutors are teachers from Quebec schools, experts in their subject areas and in exam preparation. Tutors are available this session in the following secondary subjects: français, langue seconde, English Language Arts, Secondary Math at all levels, Physical Science 416/436, History 414, NEW History and Citizenship program, Physics 534, and Chemistry 534. General Elementary Homework Help (for students in grades 3-6) is available 4 nights a week. Parents are encouraged to sit with their children while they are provided with assistance and guidance in homework assignments or projects.
