Priority of Registration

- 1st**
- **Children living in East Hill's Distinct Boundary**
(Please click on "distinct" above for a map of the streets contained in the territory.)
 - Priority of registration is given to children residing in the distinct territory on a first-come, first-served basis during the first week of registration.
 - Transportation will be provided to those students in the distinct who are eligible according to the School Board's Transportation Policy (Kindergarten: students residing more than 0.6 km from East Hill; Grades 1-6: students residing more than 1.4 km from East Hill)

- **Any child whose parent chooses our school**
will be allowed to register if space permits
 - Registrations will be taken on a first-come, first-served basis.
 - Unfortunately, transportation is not provided by the EMSB for the new students who live outside the school's distinct boundary

Documents Required For Registration:

Parents must bring the following when registering their child:

- ☞ birth certificate (long version) showing the names of mother and father.
- ☞ medicare card.
- ☞ Certificate of Eligibility for English schooling for the child being registered, if available; if not, bring with you
 - the Certificate of Eligibility of an older brother/sister
 - the Certificate of Eligibility of a natural parent *
 - an old report card of mother's or father's showing the Quebec permanent code *
- ☞ * **New directive from the Minister of Education: if using a parent's proof of eligibility, the parent must provide his/her birth certificate if born in Canada or Canadian Citizenship card.**
