








Our science fair was a huge success! Thank you to all the participants and Mme Elisa and Ms. Angie for organizing this event. Winners will be announced shortly.






Grades 4 and 5 have started preparing for the STEAM fair! Keep your calendars open on the evening of May 16th, where you will be invited to come view all of their projects!







































MUSIC
