



**Sec. III History of Quebec and Canada
(585-304 / 085-304)**

Summer School 2018

Course Objective:

To support students' performance in the Sec. III and IV two-year History program, and to improve students' success in Sec. IV, the EMSB is providing a Sec. III summer school. This course will review the key historical periods covered in Sec. III in order to prepare students for the historical periods to be addressed in Sec. IV.

This summer school course is scheduled over 15 days. Evaluation will take place during class time. There will be no final exam. The final result will be listed as a "pass or fail". No percentages will be given.

Days 4, 5, 6:	1608-1760 The evolution of colonial society under French rule
Days 7, 8, 9:	1760-1791 The Conquest and the change of empire
Days 10, 11, 12:	1791-1840 The demands and struggles of nationhood
Days 13, 14, 15:	Review and final evaluation
