<b>PRODUCTION (Competency 3):</b> <i>Produces texts for personal and social purposes</i>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Use of Writing notebook (i.e. completion of entries)</li><li>• Use of structures and features, codes and conventions of a variety of text-types ( narrative texts; commentary and opinion articles)</li><li>• Application of the writing process</li><li>• Participation in Student/Teacher conferences</li></ul>
<b>Term 1:</b> Students will be issued a <b>Progress Report</b> in October. At the end of term students will write a midterm exam that will count for 10% of their mark. In November students will be issued a <b>Report Card</b> .		
<b>Term 2:</b> Students will write a midterm exam in December/January that will count for 15% of their term marks. By March 15 students will be issued a <b>Report Card</b> .		
<b>Term 3:</b> Students will write a midterm in April 2023 and a school board exam in May/June 2023. At the end of term students will be issued a <b>Final Report Card</b> .
