#### Term 1:

By October 15, students will be issued a Progress Report with comments on their learning progress, behaviour and subject-specific competencies. At the end of term, students will be evaluated through class discussions as well as individual and group work. By November 19, students will be issued a Report Card.

#### Term 2:

Students will write an open-book midyear exam (20%) and also be evaluated through class discussions and individual and group work. By March 15, students will be issued a Report Card.

### Term 3:

At the end of term, students will be evaluated based on a long-term research project (60%), class discussions and individual and group work.
