The **elementary school** projects will be on display **Wednesday, February 17<sup>th</sup>, between 7:00 and 8:30 p.m., in the school gymnasium**. At approximately 8:15 p.m., the elementary finalists from grades 4 to 6 will be announced. These finalists will have been selected based on their classroom presentations.

Other than those of the finalists, all elementary science projects must be taken home at the end of Wednesday evening (February 17<sup>th</sup>); any project that remains past this evening will be discarded.

**High school** projects will be on display **Wednesday, February 17<sup>th</sup>, between 10:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.** Parents of high school students are invited to **visit the various classrooms and labs** throughout the school to view some of these great projects. Classroom numbers will be posted in the main lobby. You do not have to present yourself at the office. Once you have been allowed entrance to the building, look at the room postings and proceed to the room/s you wish to visit.

Parents who have children in both the elementary and high school levels of our school will have to visit during the day and in the evening of February 17<sup>th</sup>, as no elementary project will be on display for viewing until later on that evening. Please observe the stated times above for each of the sectors of our school.

On **Thursday, February 18<sup>th</sup>, from 7:00 to 9:00 p.m.**, parents and students are invited to see the finalists who will be presenting their projects to a panel of external judges. On this evening, in our gymnasium, you will find the projects of the selected teams of finalists representing grades 4 to Sec. V. The winner from each grade level will be announced at a later date and will be invited to participate at the regional science fairs held later in the year.

We know that you will enjoy viewing our students' projects and look forward to seeing you there.
