- **Student Supply Lists:**

With your child's report card you will find a list of student supplies that you must purchase during the summer for your child. Some materials are purchased by the school and you will receive the letter regarding this on the first day of school. Please send in all payments for all school purchased material by September 11, 2009.

- **Home and School Association:**

On behalf of the entire staff, we would sincerely like to thank the members of the Home & School Association for the many hours of precious time they devote to various projects. A school of this size cannot run as smoothly as it does without their support.

- **Summer Office Hours:**

The school office will be closed from July 1 to August 17, 2009.

- **First Day Back to School:**

**Kindergarten:** Kindergarten students will have their first full day on Wednesday, September 2, 2009. On that day, bussing will be provided to all students who have received a bus pass.

A detailed letter has been distributed or mailed home indicating the times that kindergarten children are requested to be in school on August 31, 2009 and September 1, 2009. On both of these days, parents are asked to bring their children to school and to pick them up at the scheduled time.

**Grade 1—6:** The first day of school for grades 1 to 6 students is Monday, August 31, 2009. This is a full regular day with regular school bus transportation given to students who have received their bus passes.

- **Class Assignments:**

Due to unforeseen circumstances your child may have to change homeroom teachers in September. Therefore, all student assignments to homerooms are on a **temporary basis** until late September. Teachers spend many hours using various criteria when forming homerooms. Only for pedagogical reasons will a homeroom be changed for a child.

- **New Clothing/New School Supplies:**

Parents are asked to identify their child's (ren) lunch bag, school bag or other school supplies by marking the child's name on it. Also parents should do the same on every piece of outdoor clothing that your child wears. Every year we send thousands of dollars worth of good clothing to charitable institutions because neither child nor parent has reclaimed it.
